Northern Hills Trek

Days of operation are subject to weather

Follow the ridges of the Northern Hills for spectacular panoramic viewpoints of the Admiralty Island group, Ned's Beach, the Lagoon & northern coastline – great locations for observing the seabirds as they soar over the rugged sea cliffs below. Arriving at Old Settlement Beach for a swim, snorkel and to observe the turtles in the shallows. This is a five hour, 3km trek.

Ultimate Snorkelling Trip

Days of operation are subject to weather & tides

For the snorkelling enthusiast join this two hour snorkelling tour to four of the lagoon's most amazing coral gardens. Snorkel within the calm pristine waters of the lagoon & marvel at the diversity of this reef environment. This tour has been developed to enable snorkellers to experience the greatest range of coral communities & fish fauna within the island's stunning lagoon.

Coral Viewing & Snorkelling Tour

Days of operation are subject to weather & tides

This is the ultimate way to experience the lagoon's premier reef & coral holes. On a two-hour tour explore the profuse coral seascape & be introduced to some of the more unusual lagoon inhabitants such as the endemic double-header wrasse, stingrays & turtles. This tour provides an optional snorkelling experience at Erscott's Hole, or you can just relax on the boat & view the stunning diversity of this exotic marine location.

Mt Gower Trek

September to May, Wednesday & Friday – 7:15am

The Mount Gower Trek is ranked as one of Australia's top day walks. Take around 5 hours to reach the summit at 875m & another 4 hours to return, this trek should not be taken lightly. Enjoy the views of Balls Pyramid, Mt Lidgbird & the lagoon.

Lord Howe Island Scenic Flights

Days of operation are subject to weather

Enjoy a bird's eye view of beautiful Lord Howe Island and/or Ball's Pyramid with a breathtaking scenic seaplane flight.

Pop Up Picnic

Tuesday at 7am, Wednesday at 4:30pm & Friday at 7am

In a picturesque location enjoy a two hour, beautifully styled, pop up picnic with a deluxe antipasto grazing platter with fine cheeses, homemade dips & other yummy treats, a bottle of wine & jug of lemon infused Lord Howe Island rainwater.

Kayak & Snorkel Hire

Seasonal – Available between 1 September until 31 May

Explore Lord Howe Island's water playground at your own pace! Snorkel among colourful marine life, vibrant coral and maybe even spot a dolphin or turtle along the way. Includes snorkel, mask & fins hire per person for up to 7 days, plus 2 hours of kayak hire (once per stay).

Pro Dive Lord Howe Island

Seasonal – Dive season runs from 1 September until 31 May

Dive sites are determined on the day of diving & suggestions of dive sites to match with particular diver's interests are welcome. With over 60 dive sites you will not dive the same site twice. If diving is unavailable aboard the Explorer IV arrangements will be made for shore dives when possible. Divers with pre-booked packages will always take priority so pre-purchase to avoid disappointment! Equipment hire includes wetsuit, BCD, regulators, tank, weights, computer, mask, snorkel and fins.

Goat House Cave Trek

Days of operation are subject to weather

On this challenging, yet rewarding trek, ascend through the tall sheltered forest of the lowlands to Goat House Cave. Enjoy views across the entire island and the rugged east coast including Rocky Run, Boat Harbour, George's Bay and Red Point. Also see Mt Lidgbird and Mt Gower's summit and Balls Pyramid on the horizon. A swim at King's Beach is the perfect way to cool off. This is a 7 hour, 4.5km trek.
